DISTRICT ATTORNEY FILES CHARGES AGAINST DANNY MILLER FOR THE HOME INVASION ROBBERY OF AN ELDERLY WWII VETERAN

The Fresno County District Attorney's Office has filed criminal charges against Danny Miller (20, of Fresno) for the Home Invasion Robbery of 89-year-old Robert Christiansen, a WWII veteran on July 7, 2016.

Danny Miller has been charged with home invasion robbery, residential burglary and elder abuse related to the assault last Thursday. It is also alleged that the defendant caused great bodily injury during the commission of those crimes.

Mr. Miller is currently in custody at the Fresno County Jail. He faces a potential sentence of 15 years in prison if convicted. He will be scheduled for Arraignment in Department 30 of the Fresno County Superior Court on Tuesday, July 12, 2016, at 8:30 a.m.
