INMATE RELEASED EARLY FROM PRISON ARRESTED AGAIN

The Fresno County District Attorney's Office has filed felony charges against Jorge Arthuro Olivera for an incident Tuesday night in Southeast Fresno. Mr. Olivera was out of custody due to an early release from prison under the so-called "Non Violent Second Strike Release Program." The date of the decision by a Deputy Commissioner of the Board of Parole Hearings was March 4, 2016, which stated that Mr. Olivera "does not pose an unreasonable risk of violence to the community...."

The felony complaint charges Mr. Olivera with one count of Criminal Threats [Penal Code section 422, a serious felony by law], two felony counts of Resisting an Executive [Peace] Officer and misdemeanor Brandishing a Deadly Weapon. It is also alleged that Mr. Olivera was previously convicted of a "Strike" offense for Assault on a Peace Officer and was sentenced to prison in 2005 for that serious felony conviction. Mr. Olivera was also sent to prison in 2013 for Resisting an Executive [Peace] Officer, as well as Driving Under the Influence Causing Injury, felonies for which he received early release.

Mr. Olivera is currently in custody at the Fresno County Jail. He is scheduled for arraignment in Department 31 of the Fresno County Superior Court on Friday, September 30, 2016 at 8:30 a.m.
