DISTRICT ATTORNEY FILES MISDEMEANOR VEHICULAR MANSLAUGHTER CHARGE AGAINST RONDRICK STUBBS FOR DEATH OF BICYCLIST PATRICK TENYENHUIS

The Fresno County District Attorney's Office has filed a misdemeanor complaint against Rondrick Deshawn Stubbs (27, of Clovis) for the death of bicyclist Patrick Tenyenhuis in April.

On April 20, 2016, Rondrick Stubbs is alleged to have been driving his vehicle near Shaw and Leonard Avenues in Clovis, when he struck and killed Patrick Tenyenhuis, who was out on an early morning ride. It was determined during the course of the investigation that Mr. Stubbs was not under the influence of alcohol or drugs at the time of the incident.

The complaint charges Mr. Stubbs with two (2) misdemeanor counts, including:

1. Vehicular Manslaughter [P.C. 192(c)(2)]; and
2. Possession of a Smoking Device [H&S 11364].

Earlier today, Mr. Stubbs was arrested by officers from the Clovis Police Department.

It is anticipated that he will be scheduled for Arraignment in Fresno County Superior Court sometime later this week.

If convicted, Mr. Stubbs faces a potential sentence of up to one (1) year and two (2) months in custody in the Fresno County Jail.
