District Attorney Charges Former Clovis City Council Candidate Hermandeep Nagra with Petty Theft and Receiving Stolen Property for Taking Opponent's Campaign Signs

Former Clovis City Council candidate Hermandeep Nagra (32, of Clovis) has been charged with one (1) count of misdemeanor petty theft and one (1) count of receiving stolen property, the Fresno County District Attorney's Office has announced.

Mr. Nagra was a candidate in the recent Clovis City Council race and is alleged to have taken campaign signs belonging to one of his political opponents. As a result of his actions, Mr. Nagra was arrested on January 28, 2021 and subsequently released on bail.

If convicted, Nagra faces up to one (1) year in the county jail. Nagra is scheduled to appear in court for his arraignment on April 8, 2021.

This matter is being prosecuted by the District Attorney's Public Integrity Unit.
