A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRESNO, CALIFORNIA, TO CALL A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018; TO APPROVE BALLOT MEASURE TEXT TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY IMPOSING A CANNABIS BUSINESS LICENSE TAX; TO REQUEST THE ASSISTANCE OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO IN CONNECTION WITH THAT ELECTION; AND TO REQUEST CONSOLIDATION OF THAT ELECTION WITH ANY OTHER ELECTION HELD ON THAT DATE

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Fresno (City), Article XIV, Section 1400, authorizes the City Council to call a general municipal election; and

WHEREAS, Sections 37101 and 37100.5 of the California Government Code authorize the City to levy a license tax, for revenue purposes, upon business transacted in the City; and

WHEREAS, as a result of recent voter-approved changes to state law, there has been a very strong interest by cannabis businesses to open in the City; and

WHEREAS, cannabis businesses are likely to create demands upon City services, and the City does not currently impose any taxes upon cannabis businesses, aside from generally applicable municipal taxes;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to seek to impose a license tax upon cannabis businesses, to be known as the "Cannabis Business License Tax"; and

WHEREAS, the Cannabis Business License Tax cannot be imposed without voter approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to submit a Cannabis Business License Tax measure to the voters of the City at the General Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, and to be consolidated with any other election to be held on that date; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Cannabis Business License Tax is more completely described in the ordinance attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference (the "Tax Ordinance").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fresno as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that the foregoing recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby proposes the Cannabis Business License Tax.

SECTION 3. The City Council hereby calls a General Municipal Election for Tuesday November 6, 2018 (the "Election") and orders, pursuant to Section 9222 of the Elections Code, that the Tax Ordinance be submitted as a ballot measure to the City voters.

SECTION 4. The question to be submitted to the voters with respect to the ballot measure shall be printed on the election ballot in the form set forth as follows:

To fund unrestricted general revenue purposes, including combating gangs, drug abuse, human trafficking and homelessness, fund police, fire, roads, and parks (90%) and fund a Community Benefit Fund allocated as recommended by a citizens' commission (10%), shall the measure to tax cannabis cultivation up to \$12 per canopy square-foot and up to 10% of gross receipts for medical dispensaries and all other cannabis businesses, generating up to \$10 million annually until repealed, be adopted? SECTION 5. Pursuant to Section 12111 of the California Elections Code, the City Council hereby directs the City Clerk to cause a synopsis of the proposed measure to be published.

SECTION 6. The full text of the ordinance submitted to the voters is attached as Exhibit A. The full text of the measure is not required to be printed in the Sample Ballot and Voters Pamphlet. However, the full text of the measure shall be made available at the Office of the Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters and the Office of the Fresno City Clerk.

SECTION 7. The City of Fresno requests that the Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters conduct the election and canvass the returns, and the City consents to reimburse the Registrar of Voters for all costs incurred by said services. Pursuant to Section 10400 et seq. of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of Fresno County is requested to consolidate the Election with other elections held on the same day in the same territory or in the territory that is in part the same.

SECTION 8. In all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 9. Arguments in favor or against the proposed measure are permissible and shall be filed with the Fresno County Clerk/Registrar in accordance with Elections Code Section 9282. Councilmembers voting in the majority for this resolution



and the Mayor are authorized, but not required, to file arguments in favor of the proposed measure. They are also authorized to provide input to the Fresno County Clerk/Registrar in determining a letter designation for this measure. Rebuttal arguments shall be permitted pursuant to applicable law.

SECTION 10. Pursuant to Section 2(d) of Article XIII C of the Constitution, this measure requires approval by a two-thirds (2/3) vote.

SECTION 11. The Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters shall give the appropriate notices for the election and shall conduct the election pursuant to appropriate provisions of state law.

SECTION 12. The City Attorney shall prepare an impartial analysis of the measure in accordance with Elections Code Section 9280 and file with the Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters.

SECTION 13. The City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this resolution with the Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters by August 10, 2018, to ensure the requisite timeframes for holding the special election as required by applicable law.

SECTION 14. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
