## WHO SHOULD GET VACCINATED FOR THE SEASONAL FLU:

**Everyone 6 months of age and older should be vaccinated**

- \* Children starting at 6 months of age
- \* Persons aged 60 years and older
- \* Pregnant women
- \* Persons of any age with certain chronic medical conditions
- \* Persons who live with or care for persons at high risk
- \* Persons who want to protect themselves and others
