I. POLICY

Individuals possessing a valid course completion record from a Mobile Intensive Care Nurse (MICN) Training Program approved by the Central California EMS Agency may be certified as a MICN in Fresno, Kings, Madera, and Tulare Counties.

II. PROCEDURE

A. In order to be eligible for certification, an individual must:

1. Have a MICN Course Completion record or other documented proof of successful completion of all components of an approved course of instruction (didactic, clinical and hospital/field internship) for MICN's as approved by the EMS Agency (refer to EMS Policy #141 for course requirements).
2. Currently licensed as a Registered Nurse by the State of California.
3. Demonstrate proof of current certification as an Advanced Life Support (ACLS) Provider according to the standards of the American Heart Association.
4. Demonstrate proof of current employment or a written commitment for employment by a Fresno, Kings, Madera, or Tulare County Base Hospital.
5. Furnish a photograph or be photographed by the EMS Agency.
6. Pay the certification fee.

B. The candidate shall receive a valid certification card from the EMS Medical Director before he/she may assume the functions of a MICN.

C. Certification of a MICN shall be granted for no longer than two (2) years. The expiration date of any certificate shall be May 31.

D. Requests for exception to policy will be made in writing to the Central California EMS Agency.
