I. POLICY

A Critical Care Paramedic may be accredited as a Critical Care Paramedic within Fresno, Kings, Madera, or Tulare County by successfully maintaining all accreditation requirements.

II. PROCEDURE

- A. To maintain accreditation as a Critical Care Paramedic, the paramedic shall continue to meet the requirements of EMS Policy #136.
- B. The EMS Agency shall issue a wallet-sized certificate to eligible persons who successfully complete all criteria for recertification. The expiration date will coincide with the expiration date of the applicants California paramedic licensure.
