## I. POLICY

The Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Agency is responsible for the processing of ambulance provider agreements and licensure of ambulance services in Fresno, Kings Madera, and Tulare Counties.

## II. PROCEDURE

The following steps are set forth as the policy for the implementation of licensure of ambulance services within Fresno, Kings, Madera, and Tulare Counties:

- A. The EMS Agency shall issue application and forms for licensure for ambulance services.
- B. The EMS Agency will review the application and all required documents.
- C. The EMS Agency will process the application for licensure and EMS inspection of ambulance vehicles. California Highway Patrol inspection reports are the sole responsibility of the applicant. At the discretion of each County, further information may be required from the applicant.
- D. The EMS Agency will provide for the development of the ambulance provider agreement and prepare a Board Agenda Item for consideration by the Board of Supervisors.
- E. The Board of Supervisors of each County will consider the Agenda Item for issuance of a license and approval of ambulance provider agreement for ambulance service within that county.
