I. TREATMENT

A. Stop bleeding

- 1. Apply direct pressure on the wound cover the wound with a clean gauze/cloth and apply pressure by pushing directly onto the wound with both hands
- 2. For life-threatening bleeding from an arm or leg and a tourniquet is available: Apply a tourniquet. Apply the tourniquet around the bleeding arm or leg about 2 to 3 inches above the bleeding site (DO NOT to place the tourniquet onto a joint go above the joint if necessary)
- 3. For life-threatening bleeding from an arm or leg and a tourniquet is NOT available OR for bleeding from the neck, shoulder, or groin: Pack the wound with a hemostatic gauze** (if available) or plain gauze, then apply pressure with both hands.
- B. Sterile dressing
- C. Bandage
- D. Treat shock as indicated

II. ASSESSMENT

- A. Check distal neurovascular status.
 - 1. Before and after application.
 - 2. Anytime adjustment is made or every 15-30 minutes.

NOTE: The EMS Authority has authorized the use of the following hemostatic agents ONLY;

Quick Clot®, Combat Gauze® LE, Quick Clot®, EMS Rolled Gauze, 4x4 Dressing, TraumaPad®, Celox® Gauze, Z-Fold Hemostatic Gauze, Celox® Rapid, Hemostatic Z-Fold Gauze, HemCon®, or Chito Flex Pro Dressing.
