STANDING ORDERS			
1. Assessment	ABCs		
2. Airway	Protect with position, basic airway maneuvers, pharyngeal airway, advanced airway if indicated, assist respirations as needed, suction as needed.		
3. Oxygen	Refer to EMS Policy #530.02. High flow if patient is unstable.		
4. Monitor	Treat rhythm if appropriate.		
5. IV Access	LR TKO – Standard Tubing/Saline lock, if indicated.		
6. Ondansetron	4 mg IV/IM/ODT. May repeat once after 10-15 minutes with no relief of symptoms. Total dose no more than 8 mg.		
	Pediatric Dose: Greater than 6 month, less than 4 years - 2mg ODT or 0.15 mg/kg IV max 4 mg		
	Greater than 4 years – 4mg ODT		
7. Transport	STAT transport if patient is unstable.		
8. Contact Hospital	Per EMS Policy #530.02.		

BASE HOSPITAL ORDERS

1. If additional dose is necessary, contact the Base Hospital.
