## CSA 34 Surface Water Treatment Plant – Update

Re: Current Boil Water Notice

Turbidity levels both within the lake and throughout the treatment process have continued to improve; however, recent and forecasted rain events have the potential to again raise the turbidity level in Millerton Lake. Staff is continuing to monitor turbidity levels in the lake and in our treatment process and working with both the State and consultants with experience in high turbidity (similar) situations.

The boil water notice will remain in effect past the original anticipated date of February 23, 2023. The revised date that the water system expects to return to compliance is March 9, 2023, pending the turbidity of Millerton Lake.
