MINUTES CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE ANNUAL MEETING WATERWORKS DISTIRICT No. 38 (WWD 38) & MAINTENANCE DISTRICT No. 1 (MD 1)

Time: 6:30 P.M. Monday, February 24, 2014

Meeting called order at 6:30 motion by Chair Holecek second by Rosemary Rabe to table reading of minutes motion carries unanimously and were subsequently approved.

STATE REVOLVING LOAN FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS (James Polfer, Senior Engineer, Design Division):

- A. Project Progress Report JP Prop 218 passage occurred and the protest period has expired.
- B. The revised State Revolving Fund (SRF) Loan Application has been completed and is waiting for approval before submission to State this week.
- C. Access Road requirement by CA State, built right next to the Wastewater Treatment Facility and will be completed by January 2015.
- D. Construction for the Wastewater Treatment Facility should commence this summer and should be completed within approximately three months (possibly by the end of year 2014)
- E. Right-of-way issues across the Lackey Estate have been settled.
- F. Loan forgiveness from HUD Livability Principals Loan Forgiveness Program of up to \$250,000 has been submitted to state of California Water Resources Division of California EPA.
- G. Due to matching funds from State, District can apply for zero percent loan to the State Water Resources Control Board (Jim Polfer).

CONCERNS DISCUSSED:

1) DISSOLUTION OF MD 1:

A. Avoid costly administrative expenditures of maintaining the budget (Cost Analysis by Julie Zimmer and distributed to CAC by the end of March).

2) DROUGHT DISCUSSION:

- A. Water Table is good, and field staff is conducting weekly soundings to insure stable water source, (currently at 20,000 to 25,000 gpd).
- B. Water pressure fluctuations, Rand Holecek interjected that depending on where the home is located on the water line the pressure may vary and in peak use periods.
- C. Anti-Syphon device keeps going off; Bob Yeatts explained that gravity feeds the system.

ACTION ITEMS:

- A. Julie Zimmer will provide cost analysis of proposed dissolution of MD 1 following which a special meeting may be in order.
- B. Jim Polfer will submit zero percent interest loan application to the State Water Resources Control Board.
