

CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE
OF THE
FIREBAUGH CANAL WATER DISTRICT

The Political Reform Act, Government Code Sections 81000 et seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") has adopted a regulation, California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Division 6, Section 18730 (hereinafter "CCR 18730"), which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code that can be incorporated by reference into any public agency conflict of interest code, and which may be amended by the FPPC after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of CCR 18730 and any amendments thereto duly adopted by the FPPC are hereby incorporated by reference along with the attached Appendices, in which public officials, consultants and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, which collectively constitute the Conflict of Interest Code (COIC) of the Firebaugh Canal Water District ("District").

The original statements of economic interests for public officials, consultants, and employees designated in Appendix A hereto will be filed with and retained by the District. (Government Code Section 87500)

Public Officials Who Manage Public Investments

It has been determined that the District officials listed below are public officials who manage public investments:

1. Members of the Board of Directors
2. General Manager

The Members of the Board of Directors, the General Manager, and other public officials who manage public investments, as defined by 2 CCR 18701, are NOT subject to the District's COIC, but are subject to the disclosure requirements of the Political Reform Act under Government Code Sections 87200 et seq..

Public officials who manage public investments shall file original statements of economic interests with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, and the District shall make and retain in its files a copy thereof. (Government Code Section 87500)

These positions are discussed herein for informational purposes only.

Statements of Economic Interests – Public Records

All statements of economic interests are public records subject to public disclosure pursuant to Government Code section 81008.

APPENDIX B
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Disclosure Categories

Disclosure Category A:

Public officials, consultants, and employees designated in this category must report the following interests:

1. Interests in real property within the District's jurisdiction.
2. Investments and business positions in any business entity, and income (including gifts, loans and travel payments) deriving from any source, that is:
 - a. Of the type to provide the District with facilities, goods, supplies, equipment, vehicles, machinery, or services, including training or consulting services; or
 - b. Engaged in farming or other agricultural related activity; or
 - c. Has filed a claim, or has a claim pending, against the District.
