CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

FRESNO COUNTY WATERWORKS DISTRICT #18

The Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81000, et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict-of-interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (2 California Code of Regulations, Section 18730) that contains the terms of a standard conflict-of-interest code and may be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing, the standard code may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations, Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference. This regulation and the attached Appendices designating positions and establishing disclosure requirements shall constitute the conflict-of-interest code of the Fresno County Waterworks District #18.

Individuals holding designated positions with Fresno County Waterworks District #18 shall file their statements with the Clerk of the Waterworks District #18, which will retain the statements and make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction. (Government Code Section 81008.)

Upon receipt of the statements (Form 700) from the Board Members and General Manager, the Clerk of the Waterworks District #18 shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of these statements to the Clerk to the Board of Supervisors of Fresno County.

The provisions of all Conflict of Interest Codes and amendments thereto previously adopted by Fresno County Waterworks District #18 are hereby superseded.

APPENDIX B

DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

An investment, interest in real property or income is reportable if the business entity in which the investment is held, the interest in real property or the income or source of income, may foreseeably be affected materially by any decision made or participated in by the designated office or employee by virtue of the employee's position.

Disclosure Category 1. Designated employees in this group must report:

The interest in real property which is located in whole or in part within the boundaries of the District including any leasehold, beneficial or ownership interest or option to acquire such interest in real property, if the fair market value of the interest is greater than \$1000.00. Interests in real property of an employee include the share of interest in real property of any business entity or trust in which the designated employee or his or her spouse owns directly or indirectly a ten percent (10%) interest or greater.

Disclosure Category 2. Designated employees in this group must report:

The investments in, income from, and employment with any business entity which within the last two years has done or may foreseeably do business with the District to provide any services, supplies, materials, machinery, equipment or vehicles.

The investment, as used in this exhibit, includes any financial interest in or security issued by a business entity, including but not limited to common stock, preferred stock, rights, warrants, options, debt instruments and any partnership interest or other ownership interest. Investments of any individual also include a pro rata share of investments of any business entity or trust in which the designated employee or his or her spouse owns directly, indirectly, or beneficially a ten percent (10%) interest or greater.

Investment does not include a time or demand deposit in a financial institution, shares in a credit union, any insurance policy or any bond or other debt instrument issued by any government or governmental agency.

No investment or interest in real property is reportable unless its fair market value exceeds \$1000.00. No source of income is reportable unless the income received by or promised to the public official aggregates \$250.00 in value (\$25.00 if a gift) during the preceding twelve month period.
