

Profile of SVP Jeffrey Snyder



Mr. Jeffrey Snyder (61 years old, DOB: 08/03/1955) has been diagnosed with: pedophilia, sexually attracted to males, non-exclusive type. Mr. Snyder's criminal history consists of:

1. 1979 – charged with PC 236 (false imprisonment); PC 314 (indecent exposure); PC 647(a) (soliciting a lewd act) – charges dismissed after 6 months of counseling;
2. October 1979 – convicted of PC 288 (lewd and lascivious act with a child) – received a 3 year commitment to the CDCR, and found to be a Mentally Disordered Sex Offender;
3. March 1985 – convicted of PC 288(b)(2) (oral copulation with a child under the age of 16) – received a 3 year commitment to the CDCR;
4. November 1988 – convicted of PC 647.6 (annoying or molesting a child) – received a 2 year commitment to the CDCR;
5. February 1989 – convicted of PC 647.7 (annoying a child under the age of 18) – received a 6 year concurrent commitment to the CDCR;
6. 1992 – parole violation due to contact with a 17-year-old male – returned to CDCR for 1 year;
7. September 1994 – convicted of PC 647.6 (annoying or molesting a child) – received a 10 year commitment to the CDCR; and
8. September 2002 – parole violation due to having contact with a minor.

Mr. Snyder's victim type are males between the ages of 8-17

Upon Mr. Snyder's release from prison in 2003, the Fresno County District Attorney's office filed a petition to declare Mr. Snyder an SVP pursuant to W&I Code section 6600 based on evaluations from the Department of State Hospital (DSH) doctor's reports opining that Mr. Snyder met the qualifications as an SVP.

A trial on that petition was held in February 2006 and the finder of fact found the petition true. Mr. Snyder was committed to the DSH as a Sexually Violent Predator for a period of two years.

In December 2007, the Fresno County District Attorney's Office filed a second petition to find that Mr. Snyder continued to be an SVP. (SVP commitments originally lasted for 2 years, but after

a change in the law, current commitments are indeterminate until such time as the hospital or individual can show that they no longer meet the criteria as an SVP.)

Since the original commitment in 2006, Mr. Snyder has been in the custody of the DSH receiving sex offender treatment. He has progressed in that treatment to the point where is awaiting the final phase of treatment, with is outpatient treatment through the Conditional Release Program (CONREP).

Mr. Snyder is currently residing in Fresno County as a “transient” on outpatient status. Should Liberty Healthcare find suitable permanent housing for Mr. Snyder, a court hearing will be scheduled and the public will be given the opportunity to voice their opinions as to the proposed placement.
