

**Provider Meeting
February 4, 2009**

Highlights

RFP'S

Residential RFP has closed. Letters sent and will start contract negotiations. Outpatient RFP was released on 12/19/08 and will close on 2/6/09. Services for the Juvenile Justice Campus tentative release is 2/6/09. Should close one month after release around first week in March.

UPDATES - CADPAAC

The Governor's budget is in first draft and in December proposed all AOD will come under a new excise tax. If passed, Fresno could receive increase to funding amount, excluding Drug-Medi-Cal.

CalOMS

ADP has made enhancements to the CalOMS data collection system. Documents that pertain to the current changes are available on the ADP CalOMS Tx website. These changes made would only affect Drug-Medi-Cal providers.

MINKOFF/CLINE

Minkoff/Cline have been very positive of AOD providers. Met with Prevention providers also. Next visits are scheduled for 4/30/09 and 5/1/09. Next Change Agent meeting is scheduled for 2/23/09 from 3-5 pm, location to be determined.

COUNTY AOD 5 YEAR PREVENTION PLAN

Work Groups are being identified and looking for data from local CBO's for input into the plan.

NIA TX

Language is being placed in County contracts on the use of the NiaTx model. UCLA will be providing training and is looking for four Drug Medi-Cal providers to participate. Providers can go to the Nia Tx website to get updates and participate on conference calls. Suggest sending e-mail once walkthrough has been completed.

OTHER

Drug Medi-Cal

Asking providers to project what they will be spending. May need to increase amounts.

ADAB

The ADAB is asking AOD programs if they would do presentations for the Board. If you are interested, see staff.
