

**Treatment Provider Meeting
February 6, 2008**

HIGHLIGHTS

Introductions were given.

CONTRACT LANGUAGE-PROVIDER INPUT

Looking for provider input to develop new language in contracts for services. Will send out a request for participants to provide input on the new language.

CADPAAC BRIEFING/N.O.R.A.

The State is proposing a 10% cross the board cut to State programs. This includes Prop. 36, Offender Treatment Program, Drug Medi-Cal, Drug Court and Perinatal services. Currently there is a 3% reduction for this year except for Drug-Medi-Cal. Will be looking at other funds to roll into Prop 36 if 10% cut happens. There is a possible rate reduction of 10% for Drug Medi-Cal. UCLA will conduct a performance study on CalOMS.

N.O.R.A. – The Nonviolent Offender Rehabilitation Action is an initiative that is being spearheaded by the Drug Policy Alliance for possible placement on the November ballot. If passed, the initiative will include funding which will be much larger than Prop. 36.

MINKOFF/CLINE

Gave update on last visit. The Co-occurring Proclamation was brought before the Board of Supervisors on 2/5/08. Next visit by Minkoff/Cline will be in May.

CALOMS DATA

Distributed and discussed the CalOMS reports. Providers will be able to pull own reports. State is looking at outcome data for funding which will include changing to purchase outcome instead of slots.

OTHER ITEMS

Year End Cost Reports are 5 weeks late on settlements. All checks will be sent hopefully by 2/7/08.
