

**Provider Meeting  
June 1, 2011**

**Highlights**

**1. Governor's Budget - Realignment**

Realignment will change the way business is done. The County will receive one lump amount with a county match, which will be distributed through contracts. We are asking for suggestions from providers who fall under Title 22, which changes could take affect by next month. The Board of Supervisors will have discretion on how monies will be spent, but we are hoping for an entitlement program. By November, we may need to limit funding growth.

**2. Electronic Health Records**

There is a requirement that all health records need to be electronic by 2014. We will look into combining smaller programs so the expense is not a huge impact to these programs.

**3. Prevention RFP**

We will be asking for support from the Advisory Board by the end of June or July for the Marijuana Initiative and Evaluator for Prevention. County Purchasing will be sending out award letters.

Youth Leadership has translated their "Wasted" video into a Spanish format. DVD's are now available in both English and Spanish.

California Health Collaborative will be holding a Teen Prescription Forum on June 17<sup>th</sup> at CSUF.

**4. Drug Medi-Cal 2011-12 Rates**

There is a 3% increase to the Drug Medi-Cal rate for FY 2011-12 which will go into effect on July 1, 2011, unless State budget is not passed.

**5. PSN Funding**

Funding for PSN was expected to be suspended as of July 1, 2011. As of last week, State is asking to hold off on suspension.

## **6. New Services**

Detox/Stabilization services will begin July 1, 2011 and will be co-ed through CAP. Sober Living services will also begin July 1, 2011 and will be for clients already in outpatient services. Turning Point, King of Kings, Westcare will be providing sober living services.

## **7. Contract Extensions**

Board date for the Contract extensions is scheduled for June 7, 2011. There is a possibility that the item may get pulled but will send out an e-mail to the affected providers if it is pulled for discussion by the Board. We would like participation from providers if this happens.
