Effective Monday, October 15, 2018 at 0900 hours, Tulare Regional Medical Center will resume operations as a hospital. The emergency department has been approved by the EMS Agency to receive ambulances.

Tulare Regional Medical Center **is not** a base hospital and will be an ambulance receiving hospital only. Ambulance personnel will need to contact a base hospital, as needed, for orders or RMCTs.

Until further notice, Tulare Regional Medical Center has requested an ETA call-in for all transports to its facility.
