We received your August 19, 2009 request for Training, Technical Assistance and Capacity Building funds, which is from the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Statewide Project. On behalf of the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC), we have determined that the request meets the requirements established by the Department of Mental Health (DMH) and the MHSOAC.

In accordance with Department of Mental Health (DMH) Information Notice No.: 08-37, the amount of PEI funding approved by the MHSOAC totals \$302,600. This amount includes funds from the following MHSA PEI Planning Estimates:

- FY 08-09 PEI Training, Technical Assistance & Capacity Building: \$151,300
- FY 09-10 PEI Training, Technical Assistance & Capacity Building: \$151,300
